Street Improvements

Overview

The City completed a Pavement Evaluation Study in 2023 that evaluated street pavement condition and identified streets for paving improvements based upon ranking criteria.

SHORT TERM (1-2 YEARS)

- Pavement Maintenance: North Rose (Pavement Overlay)
- Intersections (Various) – Pothole Repair and Overlay
- If Funded – CDBG Grant N. Panther & W. 4th
- If Funded – CDBG Grant with County

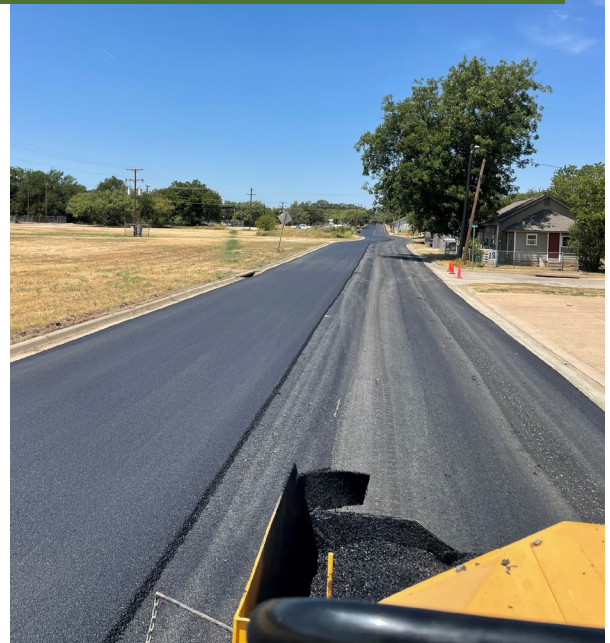

Project details

- Based upon the report, the City completed the first phase of paving improvements in the fall of 2023. The City approved certificates of obligations (CO's) to improve additional streets in the coming years.
- Currently, the City is planning for approximately \$4 million in street paving improvements in the summer of 2024 and then an additional amount of funding will be spent in the summer of 2025. While the primary objective is to level up and restore the pavement surface, some of the identified projects will address street drainage and curb improvements.
