

Boldly Leading Breckenridge

City of Breckenridge Park Improvement Projects

OVERVIEW

The Mayor and Commissioners have dedicated approximately \$600K toward Park Improvements. These improvement projects include:

- Replacing the 32-yr old playground equipment with update playground
- Building a sand volleyball court
- Adding Pickleball Courts in the Trade Barn (marking off the courts and equipment)
- Designation of dog park (fencing, seating, shade) for small and large dogs
- Updates at the Foundation Park in Downtown Breckenridge to include lighting, add turf and fountain repairs (in-process)
- Lighting at Booker T Park (completed)

PROJECT DETAILS

Playground - Bid Award to Playground Solutions of Texas for new playground for \$350,221. New playground equipment will start arriving mid-January.

Sand Volleyball Court- Estimated cost is approximately \$11K including ground prep (city employees) and Raydon providing trucking. The location will be 301 South Dunnigan. Construction estimated to start late February.

Pickle Ball Court – City employees to mark court inside the Trade Barn.

Dog Park - Estimated cost is \$25K. Estimated completion is Summer 2024.

Foundation Park – Estimated cost is approximately \$43K.
Project started mid-January 2024 and estimated completion
is March/April 2024.
